Update your 72-hour emergency kit



In case of a sudden emergency, do you have a plan and supplies ready? Your kit should contain basic supplies to be self-sufficient for the first 72 hours, including: non-perishable food, bottled water, blankets, a first aid kit, a flashlight.

Keep these in a backpack in the front closet, or another easily accessible spot. Be sure to include your pets in the plan, and replenish supplies every six months or more.



The system-wide supply mix is the combination of power sources that are used to generate the electricity consumed in Ontario. The table below discloses data for 2023, which was published by the Ontario Energy Board on May 22, 2024. Learn more and download the data.
